Step into the Heart of the Earth

Doolin Cave is home to one of the greatest natural wonders of the world - the Great Stalactite.

Located just outside the village of Doolin in County Clare, on the Wild Atlantic Way, the cave offers visitors the chance to witness **Europe's largest free-hanging stalactite**, suspended **over 7 metres** from the ceiling of a vast limestone chamber deep underground.

Discovered in 1952 by two young cavers, the Great Stalactite is believed to be **over 70,000 years old** and remains a true geological marvel. **Opened to the public in 2006** following years of careful conservation-led development, Doolin Cave has become one of Ireland's most distinctive and sustainably managed visitor attractions.

Today, guided cave tours offer an immersive, educational, and awe-inspiring experience for visitors of all ages. Above ground, guests can enjoy a full day out, including a delightful café, artisan gift shop, and a farmland nature trail with animals and native biodiversity.

Doolin Cave is a proudly family-owned and locally operated business, deeply committed to sustainability and community. **The site holds Gold Certification from Ecotourism Ireland** and has won multiple awards for responsible tourism and environmental stewardship.

Located just 15 minutes from the Cliffs of Moher and at the edge of the Burren UNESCO Global Geopark, Doolin Cave is a must-see stop on any journey through the west of Ireland.

Lit to dramatic effect after a moment of complete darkness, it's a spine-tingling experience that stays with visitors long after they return above ground.

Eco Nature Trail & Burren Biodiversity

Back at ground level, guests can enjoy a scenic self-guided 1km walk through native woodland, wildflower meadows, and take time to meet our friendly pygmy goats, Ginger and Oreo, our donkeys, Bert and Ernie, and our happy chickens – a tranquil addition to the adventure underground.

Local Heritage Through Pottery

The on-site gift shop showcases work created using 12,000-year-old glacial clay discovered within the cave. This artisan range, crafted by Caireann Browne, tells a story of Ireland's natural and cultural heritage – a perfect memento available in the gift shop or online.

On-Site Café & Visitor Centre

Featuring homemade local produce and welcoming hospitality, the café and gift shop provide a pleasant space to relax before or after the cave experience.
